Program Philosophy and Goals

The primary purpose of the Women's Intensive Outpatient Program (WIOP) is to help women develop the basic skills needed to maintain drug & alcohol free and healthy lifestyles. Chemical dependency is treated from a holistic perspective including psychological, physical and social issues. WIOP addresses the specific challenges facing women in recovery such as counseling about self-esteem, interpersonal relationships and balancing the many roles that women must play.

Treatment is offered by a team of professionals who possess extensive experience in chemical dependency treatment. Services are provided in a caring way that enhances personal growth and the dignity of our clients.

Services Offered

The Women's Intensive Outpatient Program is a six-week program that utilizes a wide range of services and activities including:

- Individual and Group Therapy
- Family Therapy
- Educational Groups
- Relaxation Therapy
- Introduction and Linkage to AA, NA, other support groups
- Referrals to Community Resources
- Psychiatric Consultation as needed
- Physical Examination
- Family Support Services

Who Can Participate

The WIOP is open to women, 18 years or older, who have experienced problems resulting from drug or alcohol use and who want to become substance-free. Women must be able to attend an intensive, six-week program, 4 days weekly, from 10:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

Cost of Services

Medicaid and many other insurance plans cover the Program costs in full. Those without insurance and who are seeking either reduced fees or full coverage may discuss their needs with the Agency's Intake Department.
